Subject: Reflex testing for urine drugs of abuse panel for patients less than 12 years of age

**Date:** May 24, 2022

*Effective May 23, 2022*, the Stanford Health Care Clinical Laboratory will send urine specimens from patients under 12 years of age who produce a positive test on immunoassay drug screens to another clinical laboratory for confirmatory testing by mass spectrometry (reflex confirmatory testing).

For patients >12 years of age, urine specimens can be sent to another clinical laboratory for confirmatory testing by mass spectrometry using the EPIC lab order codes: **LABYUCDA** (for amphetamines, barbiturates, benzodiazepines, cocaine and metabolites, phencyclidine, tetrahydrocannabinol metabolite, and opiates) and **LABFENTU** (for fentanyl).
